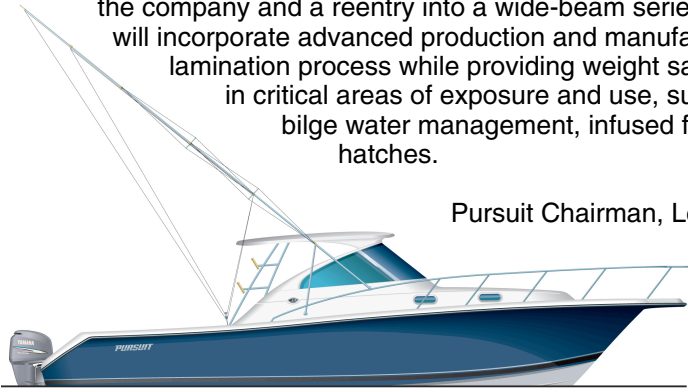
HUDSON'S OUTBOARD RECEIVES NEW PURSUIT OS 375 OFFSHORE

Ft. Pierce, Florida: Pursuit Boats proudly announces that the all new OS 375 Offshore has been delivered to Salisbury, Massachusetts dealer, Hudson's Outboard, Inc.

This also marks the first OS 375 sold in New England to a loyal Pursuit customer and long-time owner. "In fact, this is the customer's fourth Pursuit. He will be keeping it in Newburyport, Massachusetts and has just taken delivery of this boat," says Craig Hudson, owner of Hudson's Outboard.

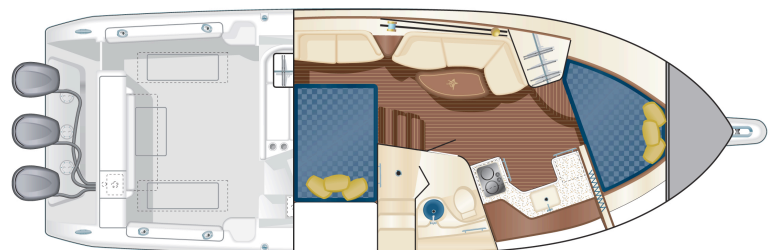
The OS 375 Offshore is the largest outboard powered boat manufactured at the Pursuit facility in the history of the company and a reentry into a wide-beam series, marking it as the flagship of the Pursuit fleet. The OS 375 will incorporate advanced production and manufacturing processes, which increase the level of quality in the lamination process while providing weight savings. In addition, the components have now added strength in critical areas of exposure and use, such as a reinforced, infused FRP one-piece stringer grid with bilge water management, infused fiberglass windshield frame and bridge deck furniture and hatches.

Pursuit Chairman, Leon Slikkers, is enthusiastic about the introduction of the new boat. "Our new OS 375 brings Pursuit back into the larger boat category, and by building it with the latest technological and design upgrades, it will truly be a crowd pleaser. The initial response has been overwhelming."

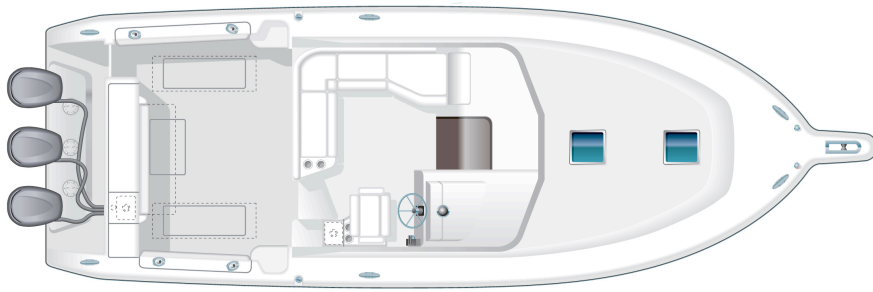


Immediately recognizable is the infused fiberglass windshield with tempered safety glass, which provides a panoramic, obstruction free view to the bow. The windshield is one of the styling features that is a Pursuit trademark and features pantographic wipers with a fresh water washer system. The cabin, with a custom convertible master berth also features a spacious convertible curving lounge/settee on the port side and continues on to a seating area which opens to the mid-cabin area. The mid-cabin is complete with overhead lighting, sleeping quarters for two and additional storage. Above the lounge/settee, a lighted cabinet with sliding doors neatly stores all of your items in style. Pursuit has taken advantage of all of the available space with smart decisions for storage throughout the entire cabin, with hanging lockers, storage drawers and cubbyholes to hold different types of stores. The galley is extremely spacious and comfortable to move around, with a two-burner electric glass cook top, polished stainless steel sink, microwave, Corian® countertops, storage both overhead and below the sink, dedicated utensil, dinnerware and coffee maker storage, and stainless steel refrigerator/freezer. Also standard is a 16,000 BTU cabin air conditioning system w/reverse heat, so you are comfortable no matter the weather outside.

The stand-up head is one of the largest in its class and features a fiberglass shower compartment w/bifold door and molded-in fiberglass seat, designer glass vessel sink, Corian® countertop, framed door w/mirror and Vacu-Flush® head w/holding tank. The openness of the interior is a result of meticulous design and engineering.

Entertainment amenities abound on the OS 375 with a Clarion® AM/FM/CD Player w/6 Disc CD/DVD changer, 6 JL Audio speakers, amplifier and subwoofer standard, and two flat screen televisions – a 19" w/DVD player in the main cabin and a 15" television in the master berth with DVD feed.

The spacious bridge deck features a tilt-away helm with horizontal instrumentation and a large area for flush-mounting electronics. The captain drives from a mechanically actuated, oversized helm seat, with armrests and non-skid poly footrest. The glove box at the base of the helm seat will be used for all kinds of storage for those offshore items that never have a place. A large L-lounge compliments the port side of the bridge deck, and features a tackle/storage cabinet aft. Captain and guests will ride comfortably thanks to a 200V bridge deck air cooling system. Behind the helm seat is a 64-quart refrigerator / freezer with a digitally controlled thermostat and drain. The standard hardtop comes complete with spreader lights, courtesy lights, four rod holders in stanchions, four recessed speakers, two hatches and canvas PFD storage. Docking is made easier with a standard 5.4 hp bow thruster with dedicated battery power.

The cockpit has a split forward-facing aft seat with padded backrest, drink holders, dockside fresh water inlet and a cockpit hot & cold freshwater shower and a complete custom-molded outdoor entertainment system with an electric grill, sink with folding hot & cold water faucet, storage, molded-fiberglass curved covers and a Corian® cutting board.

Service to the mechanical systems is easy with a large, gasketed cockpit hatch that allows access to the machinery space. Servicing the diesel generator, fuel filters, raw water pumps and power steering unit is done through the cockpit. There is also easy access outboard of the fish boxes to inspect and service the engine, house and electronics batteries.

Fishing enthusiasts will rave about the 300-quart, insulated fiberglass refrigerator / freezer transom fish box with digitally controlled thermostat and overboard drain. Included is a lighted, Oceana-blue 50-gallon recirculating livewell with vertical flow distribution. The livewell is a result of research done with a local well-known oceanographic institute and has an aerator function along with the ability to isolate water and continue to aerate, should the need arise. Two in-deck, insulated fish boxes, port and starboard, will hold 40-gallons each and are macerated with overboard discharge. The deck is reinforced for a fighting chair, the gunwales are reinforced port & starboard in the aft gunwales for downrigger installation. Eight gunwale rod holders, 4 port and 4 starboard, complete the picture. The bottom line is you can fish hard or cruise in comfort and style, powered by your choice of twin or triple Yamaha® 350 hp, four-stroke engines.

The OS 375 can run far offshore for the canyon bite or the islands, and make a great platform for any kind of cruising. The ride, performance and styling are sure to make this boat a prize among boaters and fishermen looking to move into a bigger, express style machine.
